## ACT/SCENE DESCRIPTION

Prologue: ..... An introduction to the show.  
Scene one: ..... Transylvania on the road to Dracula's House and in his house.  
Scene two: .....Aboard the ship in which Dracula is traveling to England. Some  
days later.  
Scene three: ..... Lucy, Mina, and Dr. Westfeldt's home/mental asylum. Next day.  
Scene four: .....The Westfeldt's drawing room. Lucy and Jonathin's engagement  
party. Next day.  
Scene five: ..... The Westfeldt home - Mina's bedroom. Next day.

## I N T E R M I S S I O N

Scene six: ..... The Westfeldt home - Mina's bedroom. The following evening.  
Scene seven: .....The Westfeldt's drawing room. Next day.  
Scene eight: .....In the countryside on the way to Withering Manor. Immediately  
following.  
Scene nine: ..... The Westfeldt home - Lucy's bedroom. Immediately following.  
Scene ten: ..... Withering Manor. At the same time.  
Scene eleven: ..... On the road to London. Very shortly following.  
Scene twelve: ..... Several locations in London and finally Withering Manor.
